No response from OMHA. A) Instructional Stream: Goaltending 1, Developing Defensemen 1, Checking Skills 1. B) NCMP Specialty Clinic: Small Area Games asked for 2 clinics to be held on the same day.
- Application has been submitted for Canadian Tire the First Shift, this program is designed to
  ensure positive hockey experience for new to hockey families and is open to boys and girls aged
  6-10. On ice activities are organized in small areas and skills stations keeping players active
  through the season. Activities are focused on a wide variety of skating skills, handling pucks and
